



The Five Internet Manners



1 Do not hurt others

Do not post bad contents or things that make people uncomfortable on social media.

2 Protect your privacy

Do not give your name or address to people you meet on the internet.

3 Do not agree to meet people you talk to on the internet

Adults online might be pretending to be friendly. Even if he or she wants to meet you, do not meet them.

4 Do not hack or access other information

It is a crime to use someone's ID and password to log in without permission. Be careful and do not share your ID and password with others.

5 If you have any problems, talk to an adult as soon as possible

If you feel harassed or troubled on the internet, talk to your parents or other adults you trust, immediately.

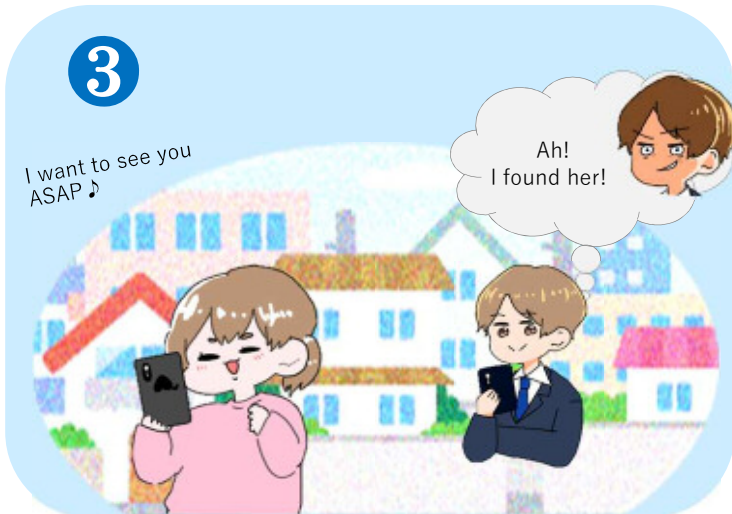

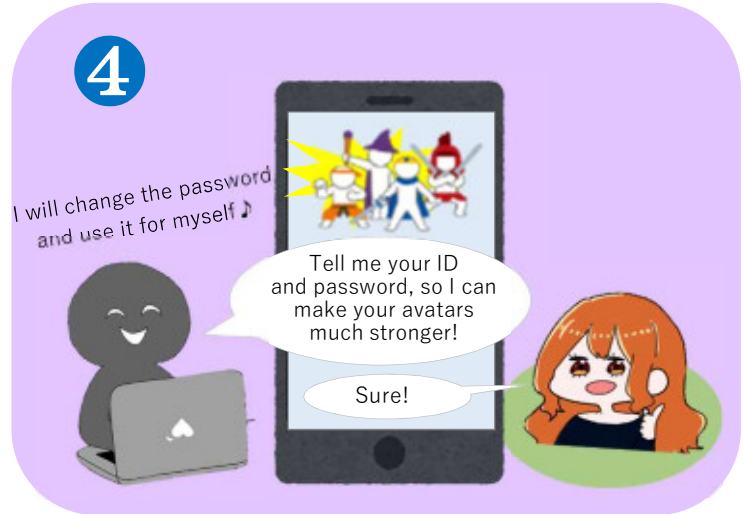
