On the partial amendment of the regulations for the implementation of the Secondhand Goods Business Act.

Revisions

From October 1, 2025, regardless of the transaction price,

more goods bought by the Secondhand shops are required to be logged into the accounting book by the Secondhand goods dealers and sellers are required to present identification.

Before revision

- Motorcycles and Motorized bicycles (includes parts but excludes parts of general purpose such as screws, bolts and nuts).
- Video games
- CDs, DVDs, Blu-ray discs, etc.
- Books



The new regulations will be implemented on October 1, 2025.

To all Secondhand goods dealers. When you buy or receive the above items, even if the transaction price is less than 10,000 yen, do not forget to verify the identity of customers and also log them into your accounting book!

Requests to those who bring the above items to Secondhand Goods shops.★

When selling the above items to Secondhand Goods shops, they will ask for identification (address, name, date of birth, occupation, etc.) regardless of the amount of money, so make sure to bring your ID, such as a driver's license or a My Number card.
