Avoid slamming on the brakes or jerking the wheel. If you continue to drive, be aware that roads may be damaged and traffic lights may be out. If you must leave your oar on the road and evacuate, pull over and park on the left-hand side. Turn off the engine, and leave the key in the ignition or leave the key in a place where it can be found easily such as on the driver's seat. Shut the windows, but do not lock the doors.
