

# Information for Potential Applicants Wishing to Enter Aichi Prefectural High Schools in 2024 (currently a third-year junior high school students)

This document is intended for third-year junior high school students and their parents.

Starting with the 2024 entrance examination, we will introduce an online application system that can access to application for all programs and all selections.

### ○ Entrance examinations for integrated junior and senior high schools

These examinations will be offered at the following integrated junior and senior high schools: Fukue High School (General Course), Shinshirokyokan High School Tsukude Campus (Humanities and Nature Course), and Taguchi High School (General Course and Forestry Course).

① **Application period:** From January 22<sup>nd</sup>(Mon) to 26<sup>th</sup>(Fri)    ② **Interview, etc.:** January 30<sup>th</sup>(Tue)    ③ **Announcement of results:** January 31<sup>st</sup> (Wed)

### Special considerations for applicants with disabilities, etc. (including illnesses or injuries due to an accident)

Based on the "Application for Consideration for Examination," the necessary adjustments will be made including seat assignment, usage of assistive devices, change the method of the English listening comprehension test, or place a nurse during the academic achievement test or interview.

### Selection process for students who have been absent from school for long periods, etc.(including past year's graduates)

○ A selection process for general entrance to full-time courses, part-time courses, and correspondence courses by students who have been absent from school for long periods due to unavoidable circumstances will be offered for all classes at all schools.

○ If you wish to apply via this method, please consult your homeroom teacher.

Selection by Recommendation for “Those who are outstanding in character, overcome disadvantages, are highly motivated, and a good example for others in their attitude toward life.”

- The process of selection by recommendation for full-time courses at Aichi prefectural senior high schools include the criteria “Those who are outstanding in character, overcome disadvantages, are highly motivated, and a good example for others in their attitude toward life.”  
Meaning of “disadvantaged circumstances” in this selection process, are defined as applicant's parent or guardian meeting any of the conditions (1) to (3) in the following table, or the applicant themselves falls under condition (4). The documents proving those reasons are listed in the “Supporting Documentation” column.
- In this selection by recommendation process, the junior high school principal will recommend the applicants after screening by school at parents, guardians or students request. Those who wish to apply should notify their homeroom teachers and submit the "Supporting Documentation " shown in the table below within the specified period by the junior high school. Those whose applications are approved should register the image data of the documents submitted to the junior high school through Web application system during the application period.

Circumstances	Supporting Documentation
(1) Public assistance recipient under the provisions of Article 6, Paragraph 1 of the Public Assistance Act (Law no. 144 of 1950)	(1) Documentation issued by the director of the Welfare Office, certifying the receipt of public assistance, or previously issued documentation establishing the receipt of public assistance
(2) Those who are not paying municipal tax or paying only the per capita portion of municipal tax under the provisions of the Local Tax Act (Law no. 226 of 1950)	(2) Tax Exemption Certificate, Taxation Certificate or Tax Payment Certificate issued by the mayor of the municipality
(3) Those who are receiving child-rearing allowance under the provisions of the Child Rearing Allowance Act (Law no. 238 of 1961) (excluding partial allowance recipients)	(3) Certificate of child-rearing allowance issued by the governor of the prefecture or mayor of the municipality (or the director of a prefectural or municipal Welfare Office)
(4) Those who have been the subject of measures as children lacking proper care under the provisions of Article 27, Paragraph 1, Item 3 of the Child Welfare Act (Law no. 164 of 1947)	(4) Documentation issued by the director of the Child Guidance Office or child welfare institution concerned certifying that measures have been taken

Notes

- 1 In case of circumstances (2), the documents must be registered with the image data of both parents.
- 2 The certified documents shall be the most recent during the application period.
- 3 For prefectural senior high schools, documents certifying (2) or (3) may also be used to apply for exemption from entrance fees if there has been no change in circumstances since the previous year.  
For Nagoya city senior high school, documents proving (1) through (3) may be used for application for entrance fee waiver if there is no change from the living conditions at the time of application.
