### Here's what an evening junior high school is like



Classes are held five days a week, from Monday to Friday.


Students learn the same subjects as those in daytime junior high schools.

Classes are run by certified teachers.

Upon completion of the classes, you will be considered having completed your junior high school education.

# The following persons can enroll

Those who are over the age of compulsory education (15 years old), live or work in Aichi Prefecture, and meet any of the following criteria are eligible to enroll.



Those who came from a foreign country and want to receive compulsory education in Japan

Those who have not received sufficient education and wish to repeat their studies



If you think you are one of those people, feel free to contact us.

### Cost

**Tuition and textbooks are free.** 

Fees for educational materials, participation in events, and school lunches must be paid.

### **About time allotment**

As with daytime junior high schools, in principle, students will attend classes for three years.

\*This can be shortened or extended up to 6 years depending on the learning situation and other factors.

The daily class schedule is 4 periods (1 period: 40 minutes).
